

# “Affiliate Marketing Scams Revealed!”

The truth is...the Internet marketing "gurus" who sell you that dream don't even practice what they preach. They make millions of dollars selling you information on how to make money selling information.

It's true. Affiliate marketing is the fastest and easiest way to start making money on the Internet. But there's a new breed online marketers that feed on people who are new to affiliate marketing by making them believe that there's no work involved.

We've all seen the ridiculous claims people make about making tons of money online without lifting a finger and how anyone without any experience can push a button and start making money 15 minutes from now.

What a crock!

I can tell you right now that 99% of these people are total frauds. All they really want is for you to spend your hard-earned money promoting their website so they can gather leads and turn a profit at your expense.

You may have even fallen prey to one of these scam artists, telling you that you can make an extra \$1000 - \$10,000 a week without a website working just 30 minutes a day! If you have, you're not alone. I've bought in to so many of these programs that I've lost count.

Fact is, if it were that easy everybody would be doing it!

I don't know why, but I have a tendency trust people. And I was "sold" by these affiliate marketing schemes time and time again. I kept thinking, "There's got to be some good, honest people out there somewhere."

In fact, I went to great lengths to investigate each site reading the terms and even contacting the owners. They all sounded good up front, but once they had my money, they could care less.

Finally, after so many disappointments, I go FED UP. Was it just me? Did I just have a run of bad luck and *happened* to join the only bogus programs online?

So I decided to find out if there really were any legitimate programs for making money online. Needless to say, I tried to get my money back from most of them. One scam artist refused to refund my \$97 even though he offered a 30-day, unconditional guarantee. He actually told me that he'd report my credit card stolen if I tried to charge back and I'd have to get a new one. What an idiot.

Surprisingly, after all that I went through, I was able to locate one individual who actually ran a legitimate program.

The owner was just an every day person like you and me who found a way to make extra money working from home on his computer. His membership area was impressive, with a good amount of quality marketing tools information on how to make \$100 - \$200 a day on your computer promoting affiliate programs. I even chatted with a few of his customers and they verified that they were making extra money through their sites.

**It was like I found a diamond in the rough.** But don't take my word for it; you can visit the site I found below. See what you think.

They do charge a minimal fee for access to the program, which is to be expected for any legitimate company that is actually dedicated to helping you get started. But it's worth every penny!

Anyway, if you do decide you are interested in the program below, I advise you to join quickly, as the owner has informed me that they are getting so many new members by word of mouth referrals, that they will be closing off membership completely in the next 2 days (by the way, you didn't hear that from me!). They don't have a large enough staff to accommodate many more people, and they are dedicated to providing excellent service to each person.

Well my search for legitimate Affiliate Marketing programs has come to an end. I have to say I was thoroughly disappointed with most of what I found, and I strongly advise that you do not take chances joining any programs other than the one listed below!
